CERTA

CERTA is a program for certifying roof system installers or repair crew members whose work involves using propane torches. NRCA administers the program, which includes maintaining a database of all trainers and applicators.

CERTA Authorized Trainer Program

NRCA conducts CERTA train-the-trainer programs to authorize trainers. This full-day program trains roofing and safety professionals on training skills, CERTA safety practices and the program's administrative policies.

CERTA Certification Session

NRCA does not train applicators. Authorized trainers conduct sessions to train experienced roof system installers on the safe use of roofing torches used to apply polymer-modified bitumen roofing products. Contractors who do not have authorized trainers accessible may find trainers at nrca.net/certa/trainers.

NRCA's Washington, D.C., office serves as NRCA's full-time advocate in our nation's capital and works to advance the roofing industry's public policy agenda in the following areas: tax policy, energy efficiency, labor and workplace regulation, education and workforce training, immigration, regulatory reform, insurance, litigation reform and health care.

NRCA was recently successful in securing several major wins for the roofing industry through legislation that makes permanent the Section 199A tax deduction for pass-through businesses, increases the estate tax exemption to \$15 million while making the amount permanent, and locks in the top individual tax rate at 37%. NRCA also was successful in restoring permanent full R&D expensing and 100% bonus depreciation for machinery, equipment and vehicles while enhancing Section 179 expensing for nonresidential real property to \$2.5 million.

NRCA continues to see success in providing solutions to workforce shortages, including a recent expansion of Section 529 education plans and the Pell Grant program to include workforce training and certification, while increasing funding for the Perkins CTE Grant program by \$300 million since 2018.




