- Q:** Why should I certify my workers through NRCA?

- Q:** Is training required by NRCA or any other organization to achieve NRCA ProCertification?
- A:** No. If an NRCA ProCertification applicant meets the experience and skills requirements, no specific training is required.
- Q:** Does NRCA offer resources to prepare and practice for the certification exams?
- A:** Yes. Candidates can access NRCA ProCertification readiness checklists and more at nrca.net/procertreadiness.
